



## MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

### Victory Cross Roads/Cross Country 2010-17 – One-piece Seat

**Hardware:** Stock 8mm Allen bolt x 2

**Tools needed:** 6mm Allen wrench

#### Removal of Stock Seat:

1. Pull out on side covers to remove them from the motorcycle and expose the two 8mm Allen bolts.

2. Remove the two solo mounting bolts using a 6mm Allen wrench.

3. Lift the nose of the seat up, and slide the seat forward over the fuel tank to remove.



## Installation of Mustang Seat:

1. While holding the front of the seat over the fuel tank, align the seat's rear bracket with the receptacle in the back of the frame. **Note: Be extremely careful not to hit the tank with the seat brackets!**



2. Slide the seat back and down into the frame.
3. Align the seat's U-bracket with the frame mounts.
4. Install the stock 8mm Allen bolts using a 6mm Allen wrench.



5. Re-install the side covers.

**Note: If the saddlebag lids scrape the seat, unscrew the front saddlebag mount, insert nylon washers (not included) between the bags and the body, and re-tighten the front mounts.**

**Passenger Backrest (if applicable):**

1. The passenger backrest can be set forward or back with the  $\frac{5}{16}$ "-24 x 1" adjustment screw.
2. The height of the passenger backrest can be set by tightening the rear knob to engage one of the notches on the post.
